




Your Liver and You

The Liver:

Is the largest solid organ in the human body and weighs over 3 lbs

Has over 500 functions. Foremost is filtering the blood from the digestive tract to remove toxins and extract nutrients.

Can regenerate completely as long as 25% of the tissue remains



Set to surpass hepatitis C as the most common reason for liver transplants in 2018


Progressive form of NAFLD






Disease Progression

Key Hurdles to Treating NASH

Identifying patients, especially at early states

Expensive diagnostic testing - Biopsy vs MRI vs VCTE (Fibroscan)
